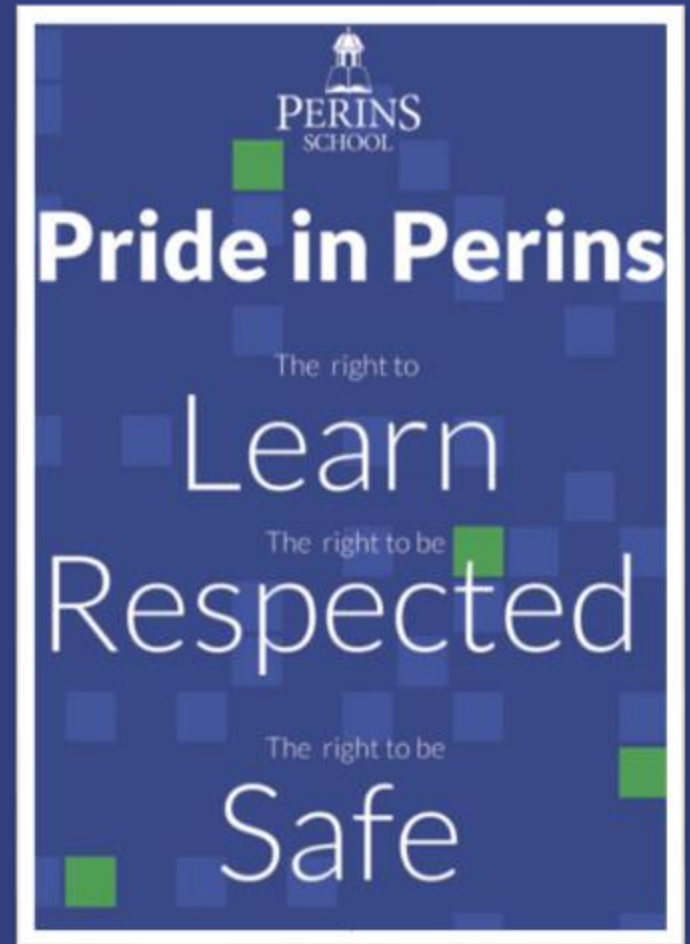

Laptop Scheme

- This will be our 13th year of running our laptop scheme
- The scheme is supported by monthly parental donations
- New students are invited to join a 3 year scheme, with the opportunity to renew and receive a new device for the final 2 years at Perins
- Students participating in the scheme will receive a brand new laptop, carry case, charger, a comprehensive suite of software, 3 year warranty and accidental damage and theft insurance
- All IT support and repairs are carried out at School by our IT engineers
- E-safety through education, filtering, monitoring and reporting
- Students are expected to bring the laptop to school everyday, fully charged and report any damage/problems to IT Services
- The laptop scheme enables IT to be used across the curriculum, which supports and develops different skills alongside the more traditional teaching methods
- Please note that we are unable to allow any other devices from home to be used at school

How does the scheme work?

- We ask parents to make a suggested monthly donation of £20, which is collected by our partners 'Edde' by direct debit
- If you are a UK taxpayer, we are able to claim Gift Aid to help us support the scheme further
- The initial scheme is for 36 months, with the direct debit starting 1st September 2022
- Until the end of the scheme, the laptop remains the property of Perins School
- At the end of the scheme you will have the opportunity to keep the device for a £10 transfer of ownership fee (to comply with HMRC rules on charitable donations)

What do I need to do?

2 step response process:

STEP 1: The Response Form needs to be completed **for all new students** to indicate your decision and/or request a call back by 22 May

STEP 2: Visit the Edde portal to complete your 'order' and direct debit mandate by 28 May. The portal orders are then used by us to place our total order with the manufacturer on 3 June
