Dear parents and carers,

We are running a 3-day Xpertise Summer School at Perins entitled "Crime Scene Investigation - Dead on Time". This is available to Year 8 students to sign up for; spaces are limited so if more students sign up than we have places for then we will hold a random draw to allocate spaces.

The opportunity will be run by the fantastic company, Thinkers in Education, and will last for 3 days from Monday 25th July to Wednesday 27th July from 9 to 3pm. This will be particularly suited to students who enjoy STEM subjects, who are keen to stretch and challenge themselves through a range of fun activities.

The CSI workshop provides an extraordinary learning experience in which students will use the best forensic science equipment and cutting-edge science techniques. Students will need to apply their best problem-solving skills to uncover twists, turns and shock revelations in a case that can only be solved with clear critical thinking. They will receive training to help them attempt to uncover the truth in a thrilling and complex mystery.

CSI Dead on Time is an in-depth experience designed to help students develop the widest range of cross-curricular skills. Participants will get a taste of real-life forensic science and exposure to the wider career options available in criminal investigative teams. They will harvest, process and analyse the evidence as a CSI unit - learning techniques from the beginnings of forensic science through to present-day DNA fingerprinting in order to reach conclusions that fit the evidence and as teams attempt to solve the case.

Place allocation

Names will be drawn at random if this opportunity is over-subscribed and you will be informed if your child has been successful in gaining a place. If the student is in receipt of free school meals or your financial situation means that you will not be able to pay the cost, please contact the finance team as we may be able to fund all or part of the place.
