The Creative Arts Department at Perins are immensely proud and grateful to be part of a school that encourages and supports the Arts. Where budgets have been cut in other schools, Perins is actively bucking this trend and investing in extra-curricular activities. We consider this vital to creating rounded students able to succeed in life and work. We recognise that the technical aspect of production is as vital as performing on stage.

Some of you may already know that we are planning to build our very own theatre space in the Sports Hall for our production of The Hunchback of Notre Dame, running from the 13<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> July. It is a technically demanding show and we are delighted to be able to offer Perins students behind the scenes workshops. If your son/daughter has an interest in the technical aspect of theatre, then this is the workshop for them. They will gain an insight into the set, sound and lighting design. As our theatre and all the equipment will be in place, the students will be able to participate on a practical level with a fully 'hands on' approach.

The workshop itself will run during the school day and students will need to excuse themselves from their lesson and must make sure that they catch up on all work missed. Your son/daughter will be allocated a time slot closer to the event itself.

We only have limited spaces available across Years 7, 8 and 9 for this workshop. The sessions will take place on a rotation throughout the day on 13th July.

We anticipate this workshop will be oversubscribed so please register your child's interest on their SCOPay account by Thursday 7th July. Please do not make payment at this stage. If the workshop is oversubscribed, names will be drawn at random and those who are successful will be emailed and asked to pay by Friday 8th July. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £20 towards the cost of the workshop. Students will be given a ticket to watch the production on a night of their choice, subject to availability. Unfortunately, if we do not receive a minimum amount of attendees, we will not be able to run the workshops. If we are significantly over subscribed, then we will explore the possibility of putting on another day to accommodate as many students as we can.
