'Perins Remembers – Our Stories' Trip to the National Museum of the Royal Navy, Portsmouth Historic Dockyard - Friday 4th November 2022

Dear parents/carers,

I am pleased to inform you that the History department is organising a day trip to the National Museum of the Royal Navy, Historic Dockyard, Portsmouth. The trip is part of the school's ongoing remembrance work for World Wars One and Two, with a special opportunity to explore the secret work undertaken by the Royal Navy. Using veteran case studies, 'multi-media kitbags' will allow pupils to interpret different types of evidence and develop their historical enquiry skills to out find more about the experiences of servicemen and women during the wars. Kitbag resources will include artefacts, photographs, face to face interviews and official documents relating to both World War One and World War Two. Students will have the chance to visit several of the exhibits including HMS Victory, HMS M33, HMS Warrior and the Mary Rose.

The visit will take place on **Friday 4th November**, and we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£25.05** per student to cover the costs of the transport, resources on the day and entrance fee. Please note that although this contribution is voluntary, if we do not receive sufficient donations to cover costs, we may not be able to run the trip. To comply with our Charging and Remissions Policy please find a breakdown of these costs at the end of this letter.

We shall leave school at 8.30am prompt and return to the Lower Bus Bay by 3.15pm at the end of the school day so that pupils can catch their bus home. A packed lunch will be needed, school uniform is expected although students will need a warm weather coat as some of the activities are outside. Students may also want to bring some spending money for the gift shop.

If you'd like your child to take part in this visit, please complete the form here by Monday 10th October.

The trip is restricted to 50 places. In the event the trip is oversubscribed names will be drawn out of a hat. The draw will be held by the Finance Department, shortly after this time and parents will be notified by email whether their child has a place on the trip or not. You will be informed whether your child has been allocated a place on this trip on Monday 10th October.

Once you have received the confirmation email, payment can be made via Scopay. If you have any problems, please contact the finance team at financeteam@perins.hants.sch.uk

Please note by selecting either box about voluntary contributions on the <u>linked form</u> makes no difference to your child's chance of being randomly selected for this trip. We ask this question to enable us to work out whether we will be able to run the trip or not. For this reason, if you have indicated that you will make the voluntary donation and your child is selected for the trip, we will need you to honour that payment.
