EBP South asked students, teachers and businesses to feedback on the impact of the Employer Interviews which meets Gatsby Benchmarks 1, 3, 4, 5, and 8 and CDI Career Development Framework Skills.









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STUDENTS TOOK PART IN THE EMPLOYER INTERVIEWS

WHAT YOUNG PEOPLE SAID THEY LEARNT

"To be able to make eye contact and be more confident."

"A more detailed idea of what I want to do as a career."

"The way to react to questions from an interviewer - ways to structure answers etc."

"I will take away that I have more to offer than I thought and that if I believe in myself I can do it."

"I should talk more about being a team player and be open to constructive feedback."

"How to talk to someone about skills and take your time. Ask the interviewer questions to demonstrate interest."

"That I didn't need to be nervous before the interview - it went better than expected."

"To stay presentable and keep having a positive demenor."

"Just to talk about myself and achievements and to be more confident with different people."

"That it is important to be polite and confident and good to engage in conversation."

"An increase in my ability to confidently present my views and ideas."

"It helped me for when I need to prepare for an interview."



Of student respondents said "My presentation skills have improved."

Of student respondents said "I can change the way I speak about a topic or communicate to someone depending on who I'm talking to (e.g. a friend vs an employer)."
