Why make GCSE option choices now?

- To enable deeper learning over time.
- Become more familiar with the soft skills necessary for GCSE exams.
- Time to learn and retain subject knowledge and skills and the demands of the GCSE syllabus.
- Aiming for good quality GCSEs





All students take Non-Examined Compulsory Subjects

Core Physical Education

two lessons per week

Life Studies

one lesson per fortnight in Year 9

Religious Education

one lesson per fortnight



ALL students will be examined in the Compulsory Subjects

English – English Language and English Literature (2 GCSEs)

Maths - Two calculator, and one non-calculator exams (1 GCSE)

Science – Combined Science (2 GCSEs) OR Separate Sciences (3 GCSEs)

- In Year 9 all students will study the same material based on the Combined Science specification.
- At the end of Year 9, trial exams, along with other assessment data will determine those students who will follow the separate science courses and those who will remain on the combined science course.

- Students will continue to learn the language they are currently studying.
- Anyone wishing to study an additional, second language, must discuss this with Mr Eastham (<u>Eastham@perins.hants.sch.uk</u>) first, as this will require approval.



What happens after Year 9?

- There will be a process towards the end of Year 9 to reduce the number of subjects taken from 5 to 4 for Years 10 and 11.
- Students will be asked to input, and the final decision will be made with them, by members of staff.
 - We will be looking at the broader picture using all relevant data and information.

What should you choose?

•Come to the Year 8 Options Evening at school and bring your parents too. Ask lots of questions; what's involved in a course? Does it look like something you'd enjoy for three years?

•Talk to your parents, tutor and teachers for advice and anyone else you know who has taken a similar course.

•Aim for a balance. How do subjects link together? Are you looking towards a particular career, Have you thought about which subjects are more practical and which have more written work?
